### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Information on how to enter and the prize form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this “Win Adelaide Equestrian Festival Tickets 2025” Promotion (**Promotion**) is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
2. The Promoter is Adelaide Central Plaza Pty Ltd ACN 000 229 381 care of Centre Management, Adelaide Central Plaza shopping centre, 100 Rundle Mall, Adelaide SA 5000 (**Promoter**).

### ELIGIBILITY

3. Entry is only open to **residents of Australia** who are aged **18 years and over**.
4.
